Workshop Programme

The intensive two and a half day programmes - which run from 0830 on Friday to 1200 on Sunday and consist of ten ninety minute sessions - are designed to re-energise experienced teachers. The workshops will be interactive in nature and there will be a focus on best teaching practice. Participants will also be invited to share examples of successful classroom strategies.

Registration Fee

The registration fee for the workshop is **680 euros** or **580 pounds**. This covers tuition, workshop materials, lunch on Friday and Saturday, and coffee & refreshments.

Registration Deadline

The deadline for registration is **12th February 2010**. Applications received after that date will be considered if space remains available. To guarantee your place, we recommend that you apply early.

Hotel Accommodation

Accommodation is available at the Golden Tulip Berlin - Hotel Hamburg for three nights from Thursday, 4th March 2010. This well-located 4 star hotel is located in the city centre within easy walking distance of Wittenbergplatz, the KaDeWe and the Gedächtniskirche.

The inclusive rate for three nights bed and breakfast is **285 euros for a single room**.

Accommodation will be booked for you by *InThinking*, but you should settle your own accommodation bill with the hotel on departure.

How to Get There The Golden Tulip Berlin - Hotel Hamburg is 25 minutes from the airport. A typical taxi fare from the airport to the hotel is 25 euros. The nearest train station to the hotel is Kurfürstenstrasse (100 metres from the hotel).
