Workshop Programme

Registration Fee

The registration fee for the workshop is **700 euros** or **620 pounds**. This covers tuition, workshop materials, lunch on Friday and Saturday, and coffee & refreshments.

Registration Deadline

The deadline for registration is **17th September 2010**. Applications received after that date will be considered if space remains available. To guarantee your place, we recommend that you apply early.

Hotel Accommodation

Accommodation is available at the Golden Tulip Berlin - Hotel Hamburg for three nights from Thursday, 7th October 2010. This well-located 4 star hotel is located in the city centre within easy walking distance of Kurfürstendamm, the KaDeWe and the Gedächtniskirche.

The inclusive rate for three nights bed and breakfast is **360 euros for a single room**.

Accommodation will be booked for you by *InThinking*, but you should settle your own accommodation bill with the hotel on departure.

How to Get There The Golden Tulip Berlin - Hotel Hamburg is 25 minutes from Tegel airport and 45 minutes from Schoenenfeld (a typical taxi fare from Tegel to the hotel is 30 euros). The nearest underground station to the hotel is Wittenbergplatz (10 minutes from the hotel). You can also go by shuttle trains to Station Bahnhof Zoo, a 5 minutes taxi ride from the hotel.
