Workshop Programme

The intensive two day workshop will run from 0830 on Friday to 1630 on Saturday and consists of eight ninety minute sessions.

The workshop, which is designed for those actively involved or interested in this area, seeks to increase knowledge and awareness of frequently encountered problems, such as dilemmas of confidentiality, screening requirements, lack of sleep, stress, alcohol, eating disorders, self-harm, and living away from family. A range of strategies to prevent and resolve such issues will be explored, and participants will be encouraged to share their own ideas and experiences. Anyone working within a school who recognises these issues is strongly encouraged to attend!

Hotel Accommodation

Accommodation is available at the Hôtel Ibis Bastille Opéra for two or three nights from Thursday, 28th October 2010. The hotel is located in the heart of Paris, close to the popular Bastille and Marais areas.

The inclusive rate for **two nights** bed and breakfast is **217 euros for a single room**.

The inclusive rate for **three nights** bed and breakfast is **324 euros for a single room**.

Accommodation will be booked for you by *InThinking*, but you should settle your own accommodation bill with the hotel on departure.

How to Get There There are regular trains and buses from all airports to the centre of Paris. The nearest metro stops for the Hôtel Ibis Bastille Opéra are Bastille (line 1) and Bréguet-Sabin (line 5).
